

## CAMP CO-OP & LEAP CAMP 2023

A Creative Half-Day Program for Children Ages 3-8 for Camp Co-op or Ages 5-10 for LEAP Camp (as of June 1, 2023)

### Camp Co-Op & LEAP Camp will offer lots of fun this summer.

- \* Our CLAYS MILL CAMPUS will offer 6 one-week camps for children ages 3-8 at Camp Co-op.
- \* Our ROSEMONT GARDEN CAMPUS will offer 2 one-week camps for children ages 5-10 at LEAP Camp.
- \* Camps will meet Monday-Thursday from 9 am-12 pm OR from 1-4 pm.
- \* The total cost of a camp session (registration plus tuition) will be \$120 to attend each session.
- \* Children will bring their own snack to camp each day.
- \* Full day camp will not be an option.
- \* The registration fee of \$20 is non-refundable. However, should your plans change, camp tuition is fully refundable prior to May 1.
- \* Children must be fully potty trained to attend camp.

The teachers plan many hands-on activities in art, nature, cooking, music, drama, and literature which can be explored at varying levels by children at different stages of development. Each session has a theme, but there is always time for free play, for reading a book in the shade, or for examining an interesting plant on our wonderful playground. Camp Co-Op & LEAP Camp provide an exceptional experience for young children and offer a unique program. Camp Co-Op & LEAP Camp teachers are on staff at the Fayette Cooperating Preschool. They are sensitive to the needs of young children and are experienced in working with multi-age groups. Camp staff and adult volunteers provide an adult/child ratio of 1:4.

Camp Co-Op & LEAP Camp are operated by Fayette Cooperating Preschool, which was established in 1951. Co-op Preschool is a non-profit, non-discriminatory, independent educational institution, licensed by Kentucky's Cabinet for Health and Family Services.

#### **Parental Work Commitment**

\*\*\*\*NO Parental volunteer days are required. However, <u>parents will receive a \$30 discount</u> on camp fees for each day that they volunteer to work in the camp classroom. We may have limited work days available. You may request the opportunity to work when you register. If we have space for you to volunteer, <u>you will be assigned days</u>. Once your work days have been assigned, you will be responsible to trade or find coverage for those assigned days if you are unable to fulfill your commitments. A calendar of work assignments will be sent via SignUp.com for use in trading work days if needed. If you have limited availability, please indicate such in the comment box at the end of the registration form. Adult volunteers must have required background checks on file at the school. (Parents who are new to the school and want to volunteer at camp must pay for the required background checks in addition to the camp fees. The minimum fee for background checks is \$45.)
